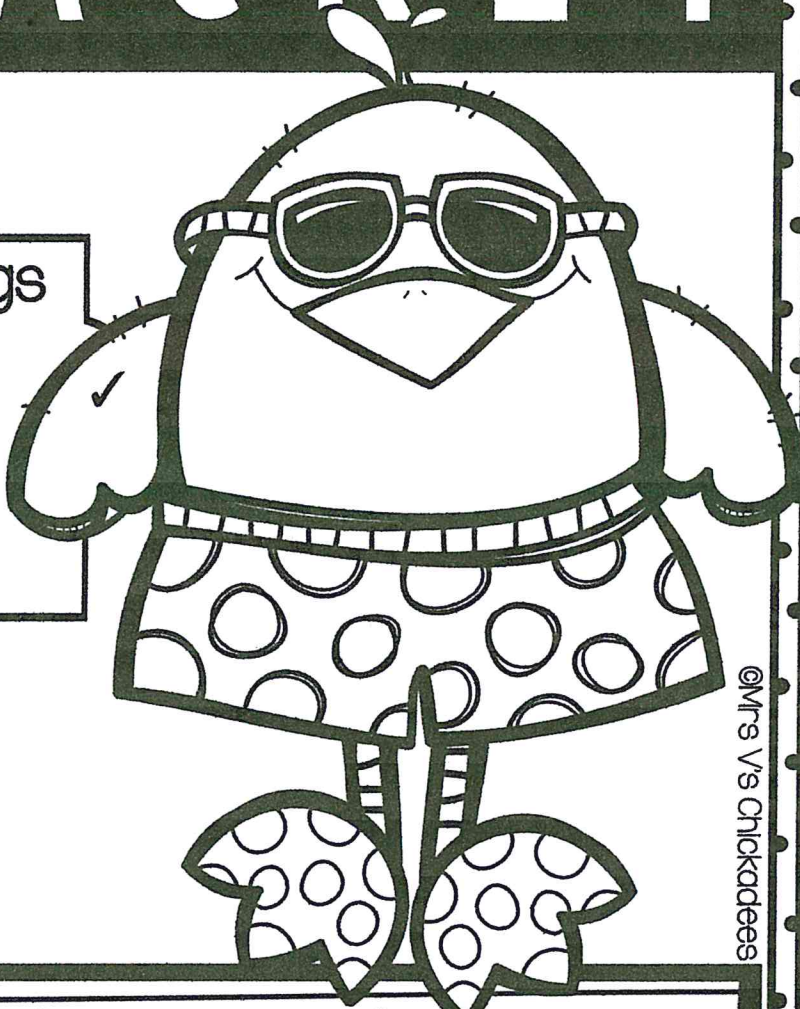

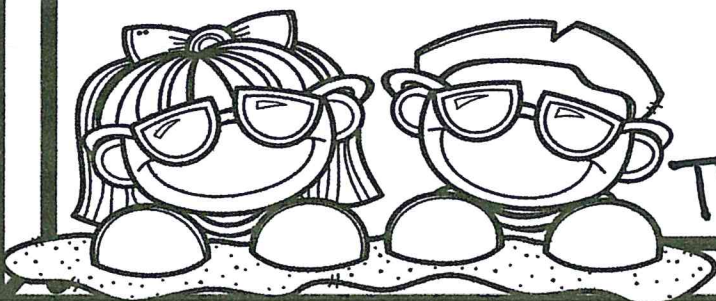
**Getting Ready for
